SCHUFA Clause

I agree to ContentCard Verlagsgesellschaft mbH sending data regarding the application for, acceptance and termination of this agreement to the credit protection agency SCHUFA HOLDING AG, Hagenauer Strasse 44, 65203 Wiesbaden.

ContentCard Verlagsgesellschaft mbH shall also provide SCHUFA with data relating to actions contravening the terms of the contract (e.g. amount outstanding after termination). According to the German Data Protection Act, such data may only be transferred if it is permissible to do so after the interests of all those concerned have been given due consideration.

SCHUFA stores the data and shares such data with its contractual partners in the EU in order to provide them with information needed to assess the creditworthiness of individuals. SCHUFA's partners predominantly include banks, credit card companies and leasing companies. SCHUFA also provides information to commercial enterprises, telecommunications companies and other companies who provide goods and services on credit. SCHUFA only discloses personal data if a legitimate interest can be demonstrated satisfactorily in any individual instance. SCHUFA discloses address data for the purposes of determining debtors. When providing information, SCHUFA can provide its contractual partners with an additional probability value used to assess a credit risk calculated from the data in its database (score procedure).
